# GENERAL HOSTEL RULES

1. Students are expected to behave in a respectful manner with everyone. Use of foul/inappropriate language will lead to disciplinary action.
2. Boarders must interact in English language only.
3. Boarders must follow the dress code as specified by the hostel authority.
4. Students are not allowed to leave the hostel premises without prior permission of the Hostel warden.
5. If any student is found tampering with surveillance cameras, TV or damaging any hostel property will lead to rustication from the hostel.
6. Students are not allowed to bring money, jewellery and objects of very high value. If found it will be confiscated. If any parent wishes to leave pocket money for their child then they can leave the money in the hands of the warden for which a separate account will be maintained for each student.
7. Bullying and Ragging of any kind is strictly prohibited.
8. Smoking, substance abuse and physical assault will lead to suspension from the hostel with other penal measures.
9. Students are advised to report to hostel authority if they have any problem during their stay at the hostel premises. Students should not take any step of any kind on their own discretion.
10. The hostel authority will do its best to help students according to their discretion and jurisdiction.
11. In the interest of safety, no student is allowed to be in possession of lethal weapons of any kind. Matchbox, lighters and highly inflammable substances are strictly prohibited.
12. Books, magazines and periodicals which are not approved by School/Hostel authorities are strictly prohibited.

13. Students will sleep on their own beds only, in their allotted room.
14. Boarders should not engage in any unnecessary conversation, discussion, quarrel or altercation with the hostel authorities. If anyone has any problem or complaints, a written complaint against the person has to be lodged with the hostel authority.
15. Students are not allowed to play any games inside the hostel room to prevent accidents and breakages. Sliding along the hand rails of stairs and running while using stairs should be totally avoided.
16. Students are allowed to bring tuck (non-perishable). The hostel authority is to be duly informed.
17. Tobacco items are strictly prohibited.
18. Possession and use of any unauthorised medicine is strictly prohibited.
19. Meals will be served only at the cafeteria. No students will be allowed to take food outside cafeteria.
20. Laundry facility will be provided by the hostel according to the needs of the students. Laundry will be billed separately. (Students must wash their Undergarments and handkerchief themselves).
21. Use of online payment apps for online monetary transaction is strictly prohibited.
22. Boarders will follow the daily routine of the hostel unless exempted on medical grounds.
23. In case of medical Emergency the hostel authority will take quick actions and inform the parents immediately.
24. The hostel charges will be ₹ 15,000/- ( Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only) per month, to be paid quarterly in advance.
25. Hostel charges are non refundable.

# BOARDING RULES

## ( Post COVID - 19 )

### Quarantine

To ensure the safety of the students, quarantine period of Seven days will be observed for the students who are symptomatic.

### Medical Test

Students need to submit fitness test report, Blood test and Covid-19 test at the time of reporting. Students with pre-medical conditions such as Asthma, Epilepsy, etc, must inform hostel authority for better management of such unforeseen situations.

### Outing / Meeting

Occasional outings will be arranged by hostel authority. No casual outing would be permitted except on medical grounds or due to some inevitable situation/event. No visitors would be allowed to enter hostel premises without the permission of hostel authority.

### Celebrations

On special occasions like birthdays, Cake can be requested from hostel authority and should be celebrated in the given time period.

### Norms in Dormitory/Cafeteria

Students should follow strict physical distance while moving around. No loitering around the hostel premises without proper reason. Dining etiquettes must be observed in cafeteria.

### Gadget Policy

Students can bring laptop (one), Mobile Phone (one), PSP and other electronic gadgets which will be kept in the custody of hostel authority. They would be using the gadgets only in the allotted time and submit it when asked by the hostel authority. Sharing of gadgets is not encouraged and students need to bear the risk of their gadgets in case of damage/loss.
